Rabbit holes and uneven ground	All participating and supervising persons	Low	<ul> <li>Hazards pointed out to all and shown</li> <li>Obvious areas of concern highlighted and subsequently avoided</li> <li>Consideration given for the appropriateness of 'dark hours' activities on the island with respect the age and abilities of the participants</li> </ul>	Very Low
Loose rocks on walls/rock outcrops	All participating and supervising persons	Medium	<ul> <li>Participants briefed not to climb walls for any reason</li> <li>Participants instructed not to scramble on rock outcrops during the activity</li> <li>Specific areas of high concern avoided by course layout or 'shepherding'</li> <li>Participants can be directly shown the areas of concern</li> </ul>	Very Low
Poisonous or hazardous plant forms	All participating and supervising persons	Medium	<ul> <li>The island is inspected regularly for any such poisonous or irritating plants to help identify potential problems</li> <li>Only known frequent plant of concern growing on Lihou is Deadly Nightshade (Berries in late summer/early autumn)</li> </ul>	Low
Rising tide and inter-tidal zone	All participating and supervising persons	High	<ul> <li>Specific attention paid to tide times and height of high water</li> <li>Group briefed by staff as to the hazards and time of high water</li> <li>Activity area to avoid areas that will flood during the period of the activity</li> <li>Inter-tidal area avoided with younger participants where they will be operating beyond the direct visual supervision of the staff/responsible adult</li> </ul>	Low
Injury caused by any of the above	All participating and supervising persons	Medium	<ul> <li>First aider present during activity and in known location/RV point</li> <li>First aid kit situated in the house</li> <li>Eye wash in the house</li> <li>Defibrillator situated in the house</li> <li>Emergency services trained and familiar with the house and island and familiar with both high and low water evacuation should it be required</li> </ul>	Low
